CLSRN Annual Conference, 7 June 2012, Calgary

The Canadian Labour Market and Skills Researcher Network (CLSRN) will hold its sixth annual conference at the University of Calgary on June 7, 2012. The conference will take place on the day before the annual meetings of the Canadian Economics Association (June 8-10, 2012).

The keynote speaker at this year's conference is Jeffrey Smith of the University of Michigan. The conference will be a broad academic conference covering all aspects of labour market behaviour and skills development and use.

Individuals wishing to present a paper should submit it, or an abstract, by Monday, January 16, 2012. Submissions should be sent to: clsrn@mail.ubc.ca. The announcement of accepted papers will be made by Monday, February 13, 2012.

The travel and accommodation expenses of individuals presenting papers at the conference will be reimbursed by CLSRN. There may be funds available for travel grants to help graduate students to attend the conference. Information on these grants as well as conference registration is forthcoming at the CLSRN website.

The CLSRN is a network of academic and government researchers interested in strengthening our understanding of the Canadian labour market.
